Information to Prepare for 2024 Competition

- Competition will be July 9-12 in Shawnee, OK in conjunction with the International Finals Youth Rodeo-Host Hotel Grand Casino Hotel-777 Grand Casino Blvd. Shawnee, Ok. 74801 Call 405-964-7777 to book your reservation and Use Code: Miss Teen
- Check in will be July 8 only from 10am until 3:00pm. No exceptions.
- You will give a prepared introduction, have a personal interview with the judges, an on-stage interview related to your platform, take a written test, compete in horsemanship, give a prepared speech, and carry flags at 7 rodeo performances.
- Wardrobe you will need:

   Contestants Choice: must include long sleeves, hat, belt, and boots; some examples include jeans, pants, skirt, long sleeve shirt, vest, jacket, or dress.
   Horsemanship Outfit: must include long sleeve shirt, hat, belt, boots, and jeans
   Rodeo Outfits: must include long sleeve shirt, hat, belt, boot, and jeans
   Western Elegance: Rodeo queen dress with boots and hat. Length of your choice.
   You may re-wear rodeo outfits or mix/match outfits.
- Deadline for entering is June 15
- Entry fee is \$250 due by April 30th, after that \$300 by May 31st, and after that \$350 by June 15th or final deadline. The application has to be submitted along with entry fee.
- You must sell a minimum of \$500 worth of raffle tickets. The raffle ticket prize is \$500 cash. Tickets are \$1 each or 6 for \$5. The contestant selling the winning ticket receives \$100 cash. The contestant with the highest ticket sales will receive a trophy saddle. Raffle tickets will be mailed to you when you submit your application. You must turn in the \$500 and raffle tickets at orientation in-order to be eligible to compete. In-order to qualify for the high ad sales saddle, you must sell a minimum of \$1000.
- Horsemanship pattern is posted. Please see the Tentative schedule.

- For the Platform Impromptu Questions & Onstage Interviews: you will write about your platform on your application. This should be something that you are passionate about. The Impromptu Questions will be personality-type questions and the onstage interview will be questions about your platform.
- Your prepared speech should be 2-3 minutes in length and can be about your state, your hometown, or a sponsor, or 'What USA Means to Me'.
- For Written Test, study IPRA website, Miss Rodeo USA website, IFYR website, horse related topics, and current events.
- RV spots will be available at the rodeo grounds. Cost is \$250. Form to be posted soon. Form and fee due by June 15.
- Stalls are available at rodeo venue. Rate for stalls is \$100 per stall for the week. Due by June 15.
- For horsemanship and carrying flags during the rodeo, you may use your own horse.
- If you prefer to lease a horse, 5 Star Quarter Horses out of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma will lease you a horse for the week.
